A- Elements for the application:

Six elements are required from the candidates:

1- Online Form (Form to be filled on the EVA 3 submission platform:

https://www.eva3.inserm.fr/login)

2- Curriculum Vitae (PDF document containing elements listed below are to be uploaded on the EVA 3 submission platform) – see list of elements to include below

3- PhD diploma (PDF format to be uploaded on the EVA 3 submission platform)

4- A brief description of the candidate's scientific career and major accomplishments

5- A motivation letter highlighting the candidate's interest in integrating the French research environment

6- Two letters of recommendation in English (should be sent directly in PDF format by their authors by e-mail to: <u>direction-ppr-antibioresistance.i3m@inserm.fr</u>)

All the documents and forms must be written in English.

The Curriculum Vitae (to be provided in PDF and in English) must include all the following elements:

B.1 - Registration

Registration must be made online, from September 21st, 2021 onwards.

- Submitted documents must be written in English
